

What is an Associate Membership?

Allows member access to all WAHU activities at the WAHU member fees (ie. CE, chapter meetings, annual conference). Does not include any national information or access.

Who is eligible for an Associate Membership?

There are 3 levels:

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

Allowed only for staff within an agency, at least one full member (WAHU/NAHU) membership required per agency first before any associate memberships can be purchased.

CHAPTER MEMBERSHIP

- Never been a member
- First 2 years at the \$140.00 level
- 3rd year full membership (with NAHU)

WELCOME BACK MEMBERSHIP

- Previous member but membership has lapsed more than 18 months ago
- 1st year eligible for the \$140.00 level
- 2nd year membership at the full level (with NAHU)
